Sheffield or the Sheff as they are called are a much older club than us (by 20 years). Some may say that the Sheffield area is dominated by their two soccer clubs but having their two rugby union clubs in our division actually more than matches that. It is fitting that Sheff are playing us today. Sheff is also a community club and espouses a true Corinthian tradition in promoting rugby at all levels. Like us its conveyor belt of juniors is vital to its success and Sheff set up one of the first Colts teams in Yorkshire after the Second World War. Sheffield were the first Yorkshire club to receive the referees "fair play and pleasure to referee" award in 2011/2012.

MUCH MORE THAN A RUGBY CLUB

Wharfedale is often held out as an example to others of a community club, always protecting its traditions but capable of producing rugby of a quality which has taken us into the national leagues.

Our first XV fields more of our own youngsters than any other club at our level, which is testament to the success of our Mini/Junior section, which our predecessors had the foresight to set up many decades ago. The Mini & Junior section not only trains & develops our own youngsters, but takes the game into many schools in the area to the overall benefit of the game of rugby. The level of commitment and dedication exhibited by our volunteers, both on and off the field, is immense.

The importance of successful transition between junior and senior player is increasingly challenging. The club is investing heavily in this by appointing Phil Woodhead as transition officer. The benefit of successful and early transition can be observed on the pitch today!

We also provide assistance where we can to help our young people with the development of their careers: several companies support us by offering apprenticeships and work experience, and from among our widespread connections we are able to effect introductions to potential employers well beyond our geographical boundaries.

But all of this costs money. There was a time when Wharfedale, in the third tier of the English game, received annual financial support from the RFU, and on one occasion we earned substantial prize money for reaching the fourth round of the Pilkington Cup. Unlike most other clubs at our level, Wharfedale chose to use its revenue not to entice professional players to its ranks, but instead, reinforcing its identity as a community club, to invest in its facilities. So, with additional help from businesses including Skipton Properties, Skipton Building Society and Tarmac, we financed, without ever resorting to debt, the building of the grandstand, upstairs hospitality rooms, the tackle shed and the covered enclosure. The weights room followed, again financed by the club with the help of its members and friends.

Any rugby club costs a great deal to run, and ours is no exception. As well as having to maintain the fabric of the clubhouse, equipment, floodlights and so on, we are determined to sustain our efforts with the youngsters. So when a decade ago the RFU ceased to provide financial support to the community game and we were left to our own devices, we needed a 'cavalry' to ride to our rescue. Thus was established the Cavalry Club, a group of individuals and companies who were able and willing to give the club their financial support to continue the amazing success that this little village rugby club had enjoyed.

Members of the Cavalry Club meet for an annual dinner and a match sponsorship, with access to players and coaches. Other benefits include complimentary admission to all home matches at the Avenue. New members are always welcome, so anyone interested in learning more should visit:

The future of the club is about our minis and juniors experiencing the camaraderie and community that playing in a team format brings. Not only is the exercise and breathing proper Dales air good for their souls, it helps them develop longer term life skills which benefits our Dales community and unfortunately as people drift away, albeit temporarily, the wider UK populace. Our first 100 years has been built on this ethos and creed. Our next 100 years will use that foundation and develop out its principles.

A good example of how our club will develop is the girls section. It is particularly interesting times for girls' rugby at Wharfedale, we have girls at u12s, u14s, u16s and u18s, meaning we are able to provide rugby for boys and girls of all ages.

In the tradition of Dr Crosbie who set up the original team due to the rugby interest in Skipton, at the moment we have set up joint teams with Skipton and Keighley at all girls age groups, which in the short term should give us enough players to field teams against clubs who have enough players to create stand alone teams. local fixtures and hopefully healthy competition in the area. In the meantime, we will try and give the girls the best game day experience we can, similar to what is available to the boys by joining forces.

Congratulations to two of our u17s girls Jessie Allan and Havana May Davies who were selected to join the Yorkshire DPP Centre of Excellence programme in August.

Today we will have our joint (Aire/Wharfe) u16s team playing West Park Leeds in a curtain raiser on the 1st team pitch from 12 noon. Just to clarify the girls will be wearing the new Wharfedale kit which has been kindly sponsored by the following People/Businesses:

This is designed with the tackle height laws in mind, as an aid to players, coaches and referees as to what is the maximum legal height of the tackle is. All tackles should be below the white band. This idea of course came years ago from the late Michael Harrison (Clarty) and has finally been put to use in the M&J Section. Clarty's influence and guidance will continue for years to come.

Finally good luck to all the girls playing today and hope you have a fantastic experience and thank you to everyone involved in making the day a celebration of 100 years of rugby at Wharfedale.

UNDER 15'S

The 2023/24 season brings various changes and challenges for the squad. We begin lifting in the lineout but cannot jump to compete on the opposition ball. A new challenge for our forwards.

We started the season with a tough test at Castleford, coming away with a 12-15 victory. The opposition were a solid test, with many of their side coming from a rugby league background. They hit hard, moved the ball well and were coached at the ruck and set piece, especially a driving line-out. The coaches were delighted with the boys fitness, tackling and effort. The highlight was a try gathered in our own 22-by one winger on the right, culminating in a try in the left corner by our other winger, with the ball moving through multiple phases and passes and the whole team involved.

New tackle laws confuse the coaches, players and public. Common sense will prevail, and we continue to coach tackling hard, safe, and low. How the game moves on with directives from on-high. The

fundamentals remain. Our club values, and those of rugby and we look forward to a great season.

This squad of come a long way from the tiny tots wearing tags, now developing into young men, speed, power, and agility running through many of our key positions, as well as the coaches. Last season we reached the final of the Yorkshire Shield, to be narrowly beaten by Huddersfield. Our other main nemesis was Blackburn over who we are still to register a win in the last two years. We beat many other sides and finished last season with a high win ratio. This year we look forward to developing further our brand of rugby which parents like to watch, and the boys enjoy. 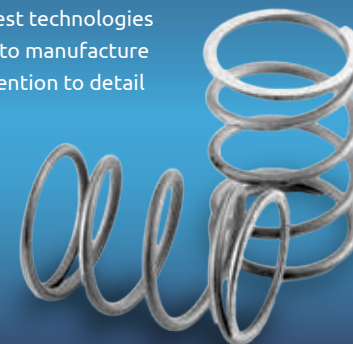

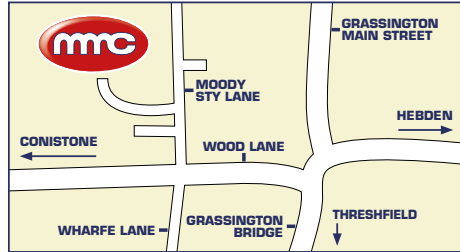
