

# **TODAY'S OPPONENTS**

Today we warmly welcome the players, staff and support of Billingham RUFC.

This will be our second meeting this season. Second? That's right - because we visited Billingham for a friendly back in August. On that occasion we welcomed them over our tryline on a regular basis, and they ran out winners 41-19. Billingham also beat us the previous August, when they came here and won 21-26.



This, though, will be our first league fixture. Billingham celebrate their centenary this year (at least we're ahead on that score). The club was originally connected with the Synthetic Ammonia and Nitrates Company, which later became ICI. Once established, the club became a force in the Durham County Rugby Union, and the first team was very strong during the 1950s and early 1960s. Sadly for Billingham, the advent of league rugby coincided with the demise of ICI, and the club suffered as a result.

Today, though, they are a community club on the up. Last season saw them promoted from Regional 1 North East. Although they currently lie third from bottom in the table, they've had some impressive results, including an away victory over Otley, a good home win over Hull Ionians, and a spirited showing against Leeds Tykes.

# **UNDER 10S**

Rugby at under 10s begins to resemble the game the majority of people will watch as this age sees the introduction of the ruck, maul and uncontested scrums.

Three very technical parts of the game and, coupled with the change in tackle height law, a lot of information for young brains to take in (and for older brains to coach and referee).

The group have shown great patience, enthusiasm and aptitude as we've taken them through the intricacies of each of these new skills. Alongside this we continue to work on the core skills of passing, catching and lines of running; encouraging the players to run straighter and pass the ball, letting the ball do the work to utilise space.

Games this season started with a 'drip feed' of the new elements of the game with all teams taking a little time to get used to the changes. After a couple of weeks, games are now full-on and the players are relishing the wrestle at the ruck and – bizarrely to a former back such as me – getting stuck into a scrum.

Our numbers remain at 12, with a couple leaving over the summer being replaced by 2 newcomers in September, neither of whom had ever played before but have fitted straight in. They've never looked out of place, and already look like they've been playing since U7s. It's never too late to start so if anyone knows a child who fancies giving rugby a go, they are more than welcome to come along and see what they think.

With the assistance of Rob and Mark and the continued support of all the parents, we are looking forward to another enjoyable season.














### **FUNDRAISING**
